Relics of St. Pio of Pietrelcina Coming to the Cathedral in Lincoln

As part of a U.S. tour to celebrate the 130th anniversary of his birth and the 15th anniversary of his canonization, relics of the renowned 20th century mystic and healer, Saint Pio of Pietrelcina – better known as Padre Pio – will be at the Cathedral of the Risen Christ, 3500 Sheridan Blvd., in Lincoln on Saturday, May 13. The relics will be visible for veneration from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. A vigil Mass will be celebrated at 5 p.m. in honor of St. Pio. The relics include a fingerless glove that the saint used to cover his stigmata, a piece from the bed upon which he slept, and a piece of cloth that he used to clean his stigmata.
