

Mission Coop Sunday

This year's Mission Coop will be conducted by Fr. Thomas Au. He will be here to speak about the Mission work in Taiwan on the weekend of July 30th. He is a priest of the Lincoln Diocese being sent to Taiwan to be hospital chaplain of the Sisters of Our Lady of China. He will give the Appeal on behalf of the sisters working in a Catholic hospital, two nursing homes and home health care in the rural areas of Taiwan. They were originally formed in Mainland China but expelled by the communist in the 1950's. Their primarily apostolate is working for the rural poor without easily accessible health care. Taiwan is about 1.5% Catholic, a total population of 22.3 million in an area 1/3 the size of Nebraska. Fr. Au will be in the Diocese of Chiayi. It has 1.5 million people with 20,000 Catholics.
