Dear Parishioners,

I've been thinking about the desire to have a strong community here at St. Vincent de Paul. As I was praying the other day, I started thinking about the words of St. John Paul II in his famous document "The Family in the Modern World". He states that societies strength is dependent on the strength of the family. If the family is strong, then our society will be strong. As I thought of that statement, I concluded that the same can be said of the community of the Church. If our families are strong then our community will be strong too.

The foundational stones of the family are the mother and father. What can be done to strengthen marriages and the foundational stones of the family? There are many things that could be included in this answer, though one thing is a deeper understanding of the fundamentals of marriage.

You may be aware that the church has a subscription to FORMED.org, which is website that provides a large array of catholic programs in video form. These videos are very well done and provide a very easy way to grow in faith. In order to watch the videos it is necessary to set up an account and you need to use the parish code which is case sensitive (XGWYQP) to register. Once you set up an account you can log in and watch any of the programs.

There is a program on marriage entitled "Beloved" and there are two parts, one for engaged couples and the other for married couples. I would like all families to watch the first video in the engaged couples section entitled "Does Marriage Matter". In this video it answers the questions of how marriage imitates the relationship of the Blessed Trinity and how marriage was designed for us by God himself. The video clearly points out how difficult the vocation of marriage is, and how permanence in the intention of the couple and the permanence of God's love and support sustains a married couple. These simple truths are fundamental to marriage and are good for families to reflect upon, not only to make your marriage stronger, but also for older children to hear before they begin a serious relationship which is leading to marriage.

I will continue to reflect on these videos from week to week, and this will be one of many ways that we can study and grow in our faith, and strength our community of faith here at St. Vincent de Paul. God Bless you.
