

Choir Practice

Dear Parishioners,

First, thank you to everyone who enter the Fire Hawks Club fun with numbers. This fundraiser was a huge success for the parish and the school. In the advertising of this event I mentioned that the funds will go to renewal of the subscription to Formed.org. I just completed the process of becoming the administrator of "Formed" for the parish, kicking Fr. Salisbury out of that role. As administrator I have the ability to check on the parish usage of the website. The most viewed programing was the weekly reflections on the scriptures. Our usage compared to other parishes was above average at 72%, and the time spent on the website was below average at 48%. During the month of September 70 persons used the program.

Personally, I think we can make better use of the resources available on Formed.org. The programing is excellent and the content is very informative. The Augustine Institute has a number of very good scholars and good faithful Catholic men and women in their programs. They provide Catholic programs for all ages. To register as a member, you need the parish code (XGWYQP) and an email address. After you set up an account you will be able to log on with your email address and with a password that you set. Using the parish code helps me to see how many people from the parish are using Formed. You can pass the parish code on to friends that are not Catholic and this is a good way to evangelize. You can continue watching the series on marriage titled "Beloved".

Please pray for my pilgrimage to the Holy Land which begins Thursday. Fr. Rooney will be here while I'm gone, and I will be praying for everyone here and your intentions while I'm in the Holy Land. Remember that there are a number of good reflections and explanations of the sites I will be visiting on our website under the title "Holy Land Reflections".

While I'm gone there will be a sign up sheet for Holy Hours on the bulletin board in the narthex. The goal is to begin Eucharistic Adoration on Wednesday November 1st. Before that date and in order for the Eucharistic Adoration begins people need to sign up for an hour. The hours will be from 9 am Wednesdays until 6 am Thursdays. There needs to be someone present in church every hour that the Eucharist is exposed. I am being overly cautious and asking for 3 people to sign up for every hour, so we are assured that at least one person will always be there. I'm sure that we have 66 people that would be willing to pray for one hour in the Church. For those who have a night hour, from 10 pm until 6 am, a code will be given to you so that you will be able to enter through the front doors of the Church that are locked down by our security system at 10 pm. I will be praying, and a host of other people will be praying that the sign up is



complete when I return from the Holy Land. God Bless you and your goodness
