Dear Parishioners,

We have completed our second week of Wednesday adoration and I think things went smoother. Everyone was able to get into the church without having to prop the door open, so we are making progress. I was reading this week about the blessings that come to us in our adoration hour. There are special blessings for those who come to pray in the middle of the night. "There are particular graces reserved for souls who keep watch before My Eucharistic Face during the night. Those who pray by night imitate My own night watches of prayer to My Father. How often would I keep vigil in the presence of My Father, conversing with Him in the silence of the night, and taking up into My prayer the secret cares of a sleeping world, and even the groans of creation. You will discover that there is a clarity and a peace in nocturnal prayer that I do not give to souls at other times. Those who have discovered this return to Me by night and seek to remain close to My Eucharistic Heart. The light of My Eucharistic Face illumines them, and the night, though it be dark, shines for them inwardly. Learn to adore Me by night. I especially desire that you should come to Me at night. You will lose nothing of your repose, for I will be your refreshment and your rest."

For years I have spent an hour in adoration in the middle of the night. There were times that I was tired the next morning, but there really is a quiet and solitude in the middle of the night that is very consoling. Stop in to pray in the evening, bring your family with you and experience the peace the Lord has to give us in His Eucharistic presence.

I have heard that some people are interested in being on a substitute list for Wednesday adoration. We will put a sign-up sheet in the narthex for substitutes. My hope is that there will be great interest in adoration that we can have adoration on more days. I know that there are particular blessings for the adorers, but there will also be tremendous blessings for our parish, our community and for the world. Those who are spending an hour in adoration have an hour to prayer for these and many other intentions, and the Lord will not be outdone in generosity. In response to the adorers generosity with their time with the Eucharistic Lord, there be an abundance of blessings from the Lord for others.

On Wednesday, November 22nd there will be a Mass at 6:30 pm. The intention for the Mass will be for the deceased Knights of Columbus, but this is also the eve of Thanksgiving. I hope that many people will take the opportunity to attend this Mass to offer thanks to God for the abundance of God's blessings. Also, thank you for your generous response to the Bishop's appeal for vocations as we met our goal last week. God Bless you.
