A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners.

Last Sunday I was going to make a push for Monday adoration hours and I forgot. There are still 4 hours that are not covered and I'm hoping that someone will pick up those hours. I would like those who have signed up for hours to come and spend the hour in Church even though the Blessed Sacrament is not exposed. Being with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for our hour is the best hour we can spend. The Church gives us guidelines for exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. We are instructed not to expose and repose the Blessed Sacrament multiple times during the day. I know it makes practical sense for the use of my time and particularly when there is a break in hours taken in the middle of the night. The guidelines of the Church direct us to have at least one person present praying and adoring when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed. So I hope and pray that the hours will be filled so we can have exposition on Mondays too. Exposition is a visible reminder of Jesus presence in the sacrament of the Eucharist, a sign of God's fidelity to the promise that He is with us always, and a reminder to imitate His humility and His love.

During this Lenten season keep praying for each other to make a holy Lent and that those who have drifted away from the Catholic Church may return. Remember that on the 11th thru the 13th, Matt Simons will be here each night at 7 pm to talk about prayer and help us grow in our spiritual lives. Mark those days on your calendar, and even if you can only make one night it will be beneficial. Pray for those being Confirmed, for those making their first confession, for those entering the Church at Easter and those making their first Communion after Easter. 
