Dear Parishioners.

First I encourage you to make time to come to the conferences on prayer that will be given by Matt Simons the next few days. After each talk I will be hearing confessions. As we conclude the season of Lent, it is a good time to go to confession. We will have our Penance Service on March 27th and we will have the priests from the Deanery here. I also want to offer an opportunity for the sacrament the week of March 19th. I will hear confessions on Tuesday, March 20th beginning at 7 pm, and then Confessions will also be available after Stations on March 23rd.

I'm going to begin encouraging everyone to mark the dates on your calendar for Holy Week. On March 26th Bishop Conley will be celebrating the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral at 5 pm. If you haven't been to this annual celebration it is something you should consider. In this celebration the Bishop blesses the oils that are used in the sacraments for the coming year. Most of the priests of the Diocese concelebrate the Mass, since it is a time for us to renew our priestly promises and then there is a great dinner afterwards in which we celebrate the anniversaries of the priests. On Thursday, Friday and Saturday of that week we will celebrate Jesus Passion, Death and Resurrection. These are the most solemn celebrations of the year, and they are a great conclusion to the Lenten season.

Finally, there are still 4 hours to be filled for Monday holy hours. I hope that those hours can be filled soon, as those who have signed up are anxious for the Blessed Sacrament to be exposed during their hour. God Bless you and keep praying in thanksgiving for God's blessings during this Lenten season and for the return of those who have wandered away from the Catholic faith.
