A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for the prayers during my annual retreat. The retreat, though short was very good. It was a great time to rest and pray and I also had the opportunity to talk with some of the priests that I don't get a chance to see very often. The focus of the retreat was the spiritual exercises of St. Ignatius which takes us through the death of sin and the resurrection to new life. The Jesuit that led the retreat had meditations for us each day and then we had the rest of the day for quiet reflection and prayer.

I spent a lot of time reading and I brought a number of books, but only read one. I cannot remember who mentioned to me last week how much they enjoyed the book that was given at Lent; "The case for Jesus". I didn't persevere in reading the book during Lent. I started it because I was interested in one particular topic and I thought I knew what this book is about and put it aside and didn't return to it during Lent. After hearing the excited review of the book, I thought I should take this with me on retreat, and I read almost the entire book during the retreat.

There are a number of things in the book that I think are very pertinent to parish life, but the most important question posed and that needs to be answered by every person is, who is Jesus, and what does He want from us? Once we acknowledge that Jesus is truly God, and that He has a plan for each of us, then we need to ask the question, what does he want for me? The most common topic that Jesus preached about is the Kingdom of God. He teaches that the Kingdom of God is among us, and that we are called to be members of His body building up the Kingdom of God. Do we view our lives in this way. If you haven't read that book, I think you better pick it up and don't set it down until you've completed it. It is a life changing message!

Thank you to all who worked so hard to make the arrangements for the Parish Retreat! I know that it wouldn't have gone as well as it did without your hard work.

Also, Deacon Alan Phan will be here on June 11, and will possibly be here for the June 10th weekend Masses. I'm looking forward to getting him involved in the life of the parish. God Bless all of you.
