## A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

As I mentioned last week it is important for us to reflect on our freedom and the blessings that we have living here in the United States. As we move into July and celebrate the birthday of our nation it is a good time to give thanks for these blessings. As many of you have probably been following the news and have watched in horror the problems we have on our border, I hope that you have prayed for our Government leaders and for families that are suffering tremendously.

In 2003 the United States Conference of Bishops published a pastoral letter entitled "Strangers no Longer" which addresses the issue of immigration outlining some basic principles. This document which is 15 years old emphasizes that a focus on enforcement of the laws with respect to immigration is not enough. The root causes stimulating an increase in immigration need to be addressed. Individuals and families are fleeing from their homelands looking for a better life, that is not possible in their present homes. Our Government has an obligation to speak with heads of state in countries whose people are fleeing to the USA, and encourage them to change their own public policies and then help these countries provide for their own people, so they are not forced to flee their homelands. The Bishops have stated numerous times that "migration should ultimately be driven by choice and not necessity". The underlying principle for every person is that we have a right to basic human needs of food, clothing, housing, the pursuit of happiness and the freedom to worship God. If these basic human needs are denied or taken away from us, then we have the desire to pursue these basic rights in another locality. Out of love for our brothers and sisters and a recognition of the blessings we have in the basic human needs that we may take for granted, we should desire to provide for those who do not have what they need, or what they should inherently possess.

Again it is good to remember that all of our families migrated to this country, and therefore we should have solidarity with those immigrants in our country, even if they are not here legally. There are many people in our country working on reforming immigration policies and are trying to help the immigrant, though at times I'm sure that the work seems to be impossible. We can encourage our state and federal government officials to continue working on just and humane policies for immigrants, and we can also show personal respect and kindness to migrants that live in our communities. Regardless of our country of origin, we are children of God, and our words and actions towards others need to always reflect love and respect for God's children. Our support of Catholic Social Services and our ethnic parishes in the Diocese is a way for us to help provide for the basic needs of those who have come to the United States for a better life. As you celebrate this week, the birth of our nation, pray for our nation, thank God for your blessings, and ask God to guide you in helping those in need. God Bless you.
