A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

Many have received an email about the survey and everyone will be receiving the survey in the mail. We will collect completed surveys in the narthex and we will send the completed surveys to Catholic Stewardship Consultants to comply the information. A report will be given after I receive the results and I am looking forward to this information from you. You have basically three weeks to complete the survey as we will send the completed surveys to CSC on August 1st.

There may be some that will say, "we just completed a survey when Fr. Barak was here". That is true, but this is very different than that survey. The focus of this survey is very much centered on the future and things that we have been working on from the strategic plan that was put together from the work of Fr. Barak and many parishioners. We have a School, a CCD program, a Godparent group, many liturgical celebrations and lots of activities in the parish on a weekly basis. The questions in the survey will help us to understand if the things that we are doing now are being done well, and how they can be improve. There are questions will help us to understand how we can get greater participation in the works that we are already doing, and if there is a need to change things to improve participation percentages. The focus of this survey is to help increase participation and increase the vibrancy of the parish.

There are just a couple of questions about the suggested changes to the sanctuary. These questions are important to our facilities committee to determine the amount of support that there is in the parish to move forward with the suggested changes. The questions are simple to determine the percentage of people that are interested in having a crucifix and the tabernacle in the center of the Church. These questions are important because the facilities committee has spent a lot of time on this effort, but it is not the primary focus of the survey. The primary focus is to build unity and participation in the life of the parish.

I urge you to complete the survey this week, or at least begin it this week, but especially by the due date of July 31st. I told our consultants that we have a very active parish and that I suspect that 60% of the parish will complete the survey. I hope that my estimate is on low end, and that we have a 75-80% participation rate! So everyone better get busy since we only have 3 weeks to compete it. God Bless you.
