A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

I will be gone this week, so I will probably not have a letter for next weeks' bulletin. I will be in Colorado next week camping and hunting and I'm not sure how much free time I will have, or how much cell connection I will have which will affect my communication. From what I have been told, there are a couple of places that there is cell connection and once a day we will go there to check our email. So I'm just saying communication will be limited this next week.

There are a couple of things I do need to communicate. This week I had a talk with Lisa McArdle, who is our representative from Catholic Stewardship Consultants. We primarily talked about our upcoming Stewardship renewal which will begin at the end of the month. We will have talks about our stewardship of time, talent and treasure and we will be encouraged to fill out a renewal of stewardship card. The focus of this is to renew our commitment to being good stewards and it will conclude with a celebration of our stewardship. We also spoke about the results of the survey that was conducted in July. I will begin going through the results with the Stewardship committee and there will be a complete report of the survey in the November Stewardship newsletter. The topics of the survey will be topics in our homilies and there will be open discussion of these topics. This will be good for our parish and to help us focus on the things that we need to do to grow as disciples of Jesus.

Also, I want to state that on October 7th we will have Adoration Sunday as a part of Bishop Conley's plan to increase Eucharistic adoration in our Diocese. We will need to begin work with the Spirituality committee to plan this event, but I want everyone to mark this on your calendar now so we have good participation in the event of that day.

We are beginning RCIA on October 1st and we need to have a list of people that will be attending. If you are interested please call the office and give Gloria your contact information so we can plan for the beginning of RCIA.

Finally, I want to thank everyone for your participation in the Joy of the Gospel campaign. Since the beginning of the campaign there has been \$277,000 that has returned to the parish for use in the three areas of Facilities, Connectivity and Future incentives. There is still another year of participation in the campaign and if everyone completes their pledge another \$295,000 will come back to the parish. So, again thank you for your gift to the Church and I encourage your continued participation in the Joy of the Gospel campaign.
