## A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

To: All Donors of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul at SVDP Parish

The Vincentian members of the St. Damien Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul here at St. Vincent de Paul (Seward) Parish have important news to share with you.

The legal structure of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in the Lincoln Diocese in Nebraska will be changing as of October 1, 2018. While operationally, the individual SVDP Conference will continue to do the good work that they do today, the parish Conference will no longer be independent non-profit associations. All SVDP Conferences in the Lincoln Diocese will become integrated units of the Lincoln Council, Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

SVDP Conferences will continue to have a physical presence in the Lincoln parishes and here in Seward. The Conferences will continue to ask parishioners for donations, albeit now in the name of the Lincoln Council. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul members in Seward will continue to direct how the funds raised in this Parish are spent serving the poor. The great works of your parish SVDP Society volunteers will continue to demonstrate the generosity of your parish family.

This is a change for the good.

For all the Conferences, because it allows the individual Parish Conferences to enjoy the benefits of incorporation, as well as tax exemption, that integrating with the Lincoln Council offers.

For the Lincoln Council, because it can demonstrate the greater impact that the Society of St. Vincent de Paul has on the community, by including the works of all the Lincoln Area Conferences in its annual reports, tax returns and fundraising materials as it advocates for the poor.

Please be aware that tax receipts for all donations given directly to, or for the benefit of SVDP, after September 30, 2018 will be provided by the Lincoln Council, Society of St. Vincent de Paul.


