A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your participation in our annual Stewardship renewal. As I mentioned last week as I have thought about the life of stewardship, I have become more convinced that time, talent and treasure are equal gifts that we are called to share with the Church and with others. I think personally, I have focused more on the gift of treasure because it always seems like there is not enough money. A comment from Mother Teresa of Calcutta was, "don't worry about money, because God has lots of money". We can say that about the stewardship way of life, "don't worry about having enough gifts of time, talent and treasure, because God has lots of time, talent and treasure". The underlying theme here is that our time, talent and treasure are already His, and He has called us to be generous with His gifts. Thank you for sharing your time, talent and treasure with St. Vincent's and with others.

We will begin preparation for the consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary on November 5th. There is a great guy by the name of Ray Mooney on the east coast that has put Fr. Michael Gaitley's book "33 Days to Morning Glory" into a pamphlet form so parishes can easily afford to provide a copy of that book to parishioners. We have purchased 400 copies of this pamphlet to use in preparation for the consecration. In the book there is a reading for every day, and there are prayers to say. There is a clear explanation a person needs to do to prepare for the consecration. The book is easy to read and is very inspiring. I hope that everyone will pick up a copy per household and join in the consecration. Even if you have made a consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary in the past, it is recommended to renew your consecration yearly.

To help prepare for the consecration Deacon Phan will be giving weekly reflections on the book Thursday evenings beginning November 8th. The consecration will be on the feast of the Immaculate Conception, December 8th. As I have done this before, on the day of consecration, people would gather together after Mass and make the consecration together, and some would come to the Church on their own to make their consecration. This is the way that I would like this to happen on December 8th. Since it is a holy day of obligation, after each Holy Day Mass, either myself or Deacon Phan will lead the consecration after Mass. I know that it will work better for others to make their consecration privately, or even in another parish. The most important thing for all, is that we have our lives consecrated to our Blessed Mother, and we will find that she will lead closer to her Son and the offering of our lives in service to God will be perfected. God Bless you.
