This week we begin the preparation for consecrating our lives to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Each day there is a reading from "33 Days to Morning Glory" and there are prayers to say daily. This book from Fr. Michael Gaitley tells some amazing stories about St. John Paul II and St. Maximillian Kolbe and how their personal consecration to Mary led them to do great things for Jesus. If you haven't decided to participate in the consecration, there is still time to do so, and the books are still available in the narthex.

During this month of November remember to pray for your deceased relatives and friends. The greatest offering of prayer for them is the Mass.
