Dear Parishioners,

I hope everyone had a good celebration of Independence Day. I extend a thank you to all who worked hard to create a beautiful float for the parade, and for all the kids that came out to ride on the float. I have to say, that a thank you probably isn't necessary for the kids, because they had such a great time. In the center of the float was a swimming pool and the kids had a great time splashing around on a warm afternoon.

The School families really do a great job coming up with very spiritual themes for the floats. The theme this year included the "ocean of mercy" which was symbolized by the pool of water and the ocean flora and fish that decorated the float. The "ocean of mercy" is truly a gift that we can and do enjoy in the practice of our faith. In last Friday's readings, Jesus said to those around him, that is "mercy" that He desires. He desires that we know His mercy and that we may be instruments of His mercy in our relationship with others. Again, thank you School families for that evangelical message in the float that your created!
