## A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, was the feast day of the Exultation of the Cross. For the Knights and Dames of the Holy Sepulchre this is a solemnity and a day in which a plenary indulgence can be received. The title has been changed in recent years as it was formerly known as the Triumph of the Cross. Either way the feast speaks of the victory of Jesus on the cross. The cross truly announces the terrible suffering and death that Jesus embraced and conquered, and it is truly a sign of hope and comfort as we experience our own crosses.

I was listening to Spirit Catholic Radio and there were two speakers that help us to understand the need for this feast in the midst of our suffering. One speaker worked with Mother Teresa in Calcutta for a year. She said that Mother spoke to her six times during that year, and on one occasion Mother said, "not everyone is called to Calcutta, but everyone has to find their own Calcutta that God is calling them to serve". The city of Calcutta is known for its poverty and suffering, yet there are people in our own communities that are suffering too, and the triumph of that cross is connected to those who are called by God to serve that Calcutta.

The other speaker called in after hearing a woman ask for advice as she and her husband were struggling with infertility. The speaker related her families experience as a sign of solidarity, comfort and hope. She said that they struggled for years to achieve a pregnancy, and finally one day gave everything up to God and His will. They proceeded with adoption efforts and were given a beautiful baby boy named Gabe to care for. Gabe was God's gift to them as they surrendered their will to God's. She said that if that had not put their family plans into God's will they would have never opened their home to Gabe. God blessed them with fertility afterwards, but if they wouldn't have let go and allowed God's plan to be theirs, Gabe would have never been a part of their family.

The cross comes to us in many different ways, and Jesus is there to bring about a triumphant victory over that cross, and He employs us as ministers of those victories. Open your heart to that call and bring the victory of Jesus to others. God Bless you.
