A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend is Stewardship Commitment weekend. Thank you for filling out your stewardship card and bringing it to Mass. There is still time to drop off a commitment card at the Church office, so please do so if you were not here this weekend, or if you are still thinking about your commitment.

Our participation in the Church is vital to our own life with God, and the mission that he has for us to bring him to others. This last week there were passages from the prophet Micah and Joel for daily Mass. They are apocalyptic passages focusing on the end times. When I read these passages I don't think about when will Jesus come again, or when will the end be. From the Scriptures it is clear that thinking about when this will happen is useless, since no one knows the day or the hour when Jesus will come again. I do think about my own readiness for the day God will call me from this life, but also I think about how I am helping others to be ready. This thought is really a stewardship way of thinking. God has blessed us with faith, and He has called us to use that gift to help others know, love and serve Him. So it is not enough to get ourselves to heaven, we have a responsibility to help others on their journey to heaven. This is why it is important for us to be active participants in the life of the Church. This is why our Stewardship commitment is important. We need to prayerfully discern how God is calling us to be better stewards in the coming 12 months before our next Stewardship commitment.
