A LETTER FROM MONSIGNOR

Dear Parishioners,

It has now been 2 years since we started our Wednesday morning to Thursday morning adoration. The hour of adoration of Jesus in the Church on those days has been a tremendous blessing for our parish and for all those who have been prayed for over these years. An hour in Church before Jesus changes our hearts as we encounter the love of God made visible in the Eucharistic host. St. John simply wrote, "God so loved the world, that he became man, and made his dwelling place with us." The hour that we spend in Church is an encounter with that love of God, and it does change our hearts.

I have not forgotten about the efforts we made in September to grow our adoration program. The commitment cards that were completed in September are still being collated and reviewed. It is still my hope and desire to increase our adoration hours. I hope and pray that more than the 78 people that filled out cards will want to be a part of the adoration program.

I have now been a priest for over 30 years and spending time in the Church praying has been a part of my daily routine. The time sometimes seems rushed due to things that need to be done. Even a few minutes in the Church praying are valuable minutes in my spiritual growth. The hour though is the best and sometimes I think I'm just starting to figure out the importance of this hour. This only makes sense, since we encounter Jesus, true God and true Man, and how can a mortal mind comprehend fully such a profound mystery? Our mortal being coming in contact with the divine reality has a tremendous room for growth, so it sometimes seems that I am only beginning in my spiritual life. Please pray for the growth of our adoration program and consider spending a few minutes, or an hour daily in Church with Jesus.

Also, remember that we have Pub Theology coming up on November 8th at Par 15. I will begin with a short talk about US Attorney General, William Barr's speech at Notre Dame. His topic speaks about religious liberty and the necessity of a spiritual life to make our Democratic way of life work. There will be questions and discussion after that, and if you want to write some questions and place them in the box next to sign up sheet I will answer those questions too. God Bless you. -Msgr. 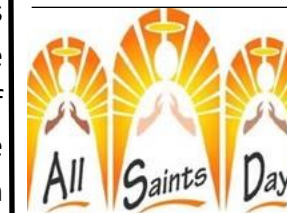

"Hello! I thought this would be the easiest way to keep you all updated on my treatments. My first treatment went smoothly and haven't felt nauseous yet so praise God for that! I pray the hiccups don't kick in when I'm celebrating Mass or that could be really distracting! But another edifying blessing that has come from this cross was pointed out to me by my spiritual director. He said since I'm a priest and conformed to Jesus through Holy Orders, the words of institution at Mass can draw me even closer to God now. Every time I pray the words, "This is My Body... This is My Blood..." I can say those exact words to the Father and surrender my entire self as a sacrifice in union with Christ and allow Him to bring about all the graces He wants to for all of us during this time.
