### A LETTER FROM MONSIGOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the candidates for Parish Council are shown on the bulletin board in the Narthex. Next weekend we will have the election for the new Parish Council members. The Parish Council is an advisory board for me, and I depend on their insights and advice. I am grateful for the three years of service our outgoing members (Jen Masek, Marty Telecky, Sandy Shaw and Stan Mitchell) gave to the Council. I look forward to receiving similar good insights from the new members.

As we continue through the season of Advent, it is a time of preparation. Last Sunday we were blessed with the Vigil Project at the Seminary. The evening was a time of song and prayer and it had a profound effect on those present. Greg, who is one of the leaders of the group talked about the importance of prayer and the connection that music has in lifting our hearts to God. The refrains of songs are generally simple, and repetition of the refrain in prayer helps us lift our hearts to God in a powerful way. One of the refrains that we heard, and that you can listen to on the CD that was given is a variation on the song "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel". The way they sang it added the words, "O Come, O Come to our hearts to dwell". This prayer to God is intimate to this season of Advent, and is a refrain that should be prayed daily. Jesus wants to dwell in our hearts, but will not come uninvited. In this prayer we invite Him to dwell in our hearts, and then He helps us tidy up that place to be a suitable place for Him. Tidying our hearts brings great joy and peace to us, and it encourages us to stay close to Jesus always, because our hearts really long for that peace, love and joy.

Next weekend we will have our annual Advent Penance Service. We have many priests from the area coming to hear confessions. Jesus is inviting us to attend and it is a part of what He does to tidy our hearts to be a suitable dwelling place for Him. Please attend and receive the gift of His love in this sacrament. There are other times for confession listed in the bulletin if the Penance Service time does not work out for you. Either way, Jesus is inviting you to make a good confession during Advent, and ask Him to help you with your examination of conscience. God Bless you.
