Dear Parishioners,

Happy Mothers' Day! This weekend in a particular way our parish thanks God for the gift of motherhood. God's plan is that we would come to life through our Mothers. Our mothers cared for us and loved us as a child, and continue to love and care for us as adults. We thank God for our mothers. Our experience of having a loving mother that gave us life and nurtured us helps us in our relationship with our heavenly mother. Just as our fathers help us in relationship with God our Father, our mothers help us in our relationship with our Mary our Mother in heaven. Our mothers give us life, and Mary is the mother of our spiritual life. She nurtured and care for our Savior, her son, and in that gave birth to our spiritual life. Mary continues to nurture us spiritually in her role from heaven. During this month of May pray the rosary daily and grow in relationship with your heavenly Mother allowing her to lead you closer to her son.

During the week I will send out an email with my reflections and directions on Mass with a congregation. Our weekly Masses have been going well, and there are still a lot of people participating in Mass in person and live streaming. As creatures of habit everyone is sitting in their regular spots. This weekend pews will be closed off so every other pew is empty. This space does not provide 6 feet of separation so it will be important to stagger seating from pew to pew to create the added space. It would be wise to wear a mask when you come to Church, and there have been some doing that during the week. Also it would be good practice to wash your hands as soon as you return home from Mass. Hand sanitizer is in high demand, so the responsibility will be yours to wash your hands when you get home. We do have some sanitizer for those distributing communion, and we will keep the Church pews sanitized to the best of our ability. We will have to work together to keep each other healthy.

This week I will be meeting with our principal and CCD coordinator to determine when we can schedule First Communion. We will be working on this and I will announce that next weekend.

If you know of someone in need of counseling for grief, anxiety or basic troubles in life, please call me and I will help find help if I am unable to assist you myself. These are stress-filled days and we need to acknowledge it and make good decisions to deal with the stress. Keep praying for God's assistance and for wisdom to make good choices each day. Also, if you know of someone in need for food or other assistance, we still have ham-burger to give away, and the St. Vincent de Paul Society can assist families with food and provide some financial assistance for various household expenses. Let's focus on taking care of all we know that are in need. God Bless you.
