## A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

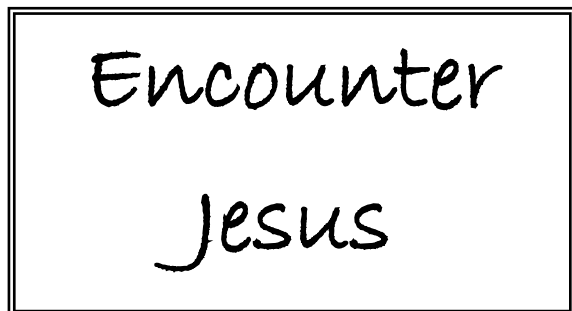
Last weekend was very nice as we opened the Church for Mass for the first time in 8 weeks. As I expected, the number of people attending Mass was small. There were 20 people at the 5:30 Saturday evening Mass and there were 50 to 60 people at both of the Sunday Masses. There were people that helped clean the pews after Mass and I am grateful for their help. Overall, I think everything went well. We will continue to live stream the Mass even as the crowd on Sunday increases. There are many people that are permanently homebound and they have really appreciated the opportunity to participate in our Parish Mass.

We are working on connecting the camera that allows us to project Mass to the Social Hall, to our Facebook page. This will allow us to use our sound system in broadcast Masses and the view will be of the whole Sanctuary. This will provide a better sound quality and it should help those participating in Mass from home to have a better connection with the parish. We have learned a lot over these last two months, and we will continue to learn about better ways to connect and grow in unity as a parish.

We are working on First Communion and will have a group celebration on June 14<sup>th</sup>. This is a perfect day for the children to receive communion for the first time, since this is the feast of Corpus Christi. There are 25 children that will receive this sacrament and the Mass on that afternoon at 1 pm will be only for the First Communicants and their immediate family. It is unknown what the situation will be around here with regards to the pandemic. We know that there may be some that are uncomfortable attending a Mass with over 100 people present. If you would like your child to receive communion in a smaller group that could happen during a weekday Mass or on a Sunday prior to the 14<sup>th</sup>. If you like that option better than a group celebration on the 14<sup>th</sup> please let me know and arrangements will be made.

The pandemic changed so many ordinary celebrations that we look forward to in the month of May. We are generally going to graduations at this time. To all of the seniors from St. Vincent de Paul parish, Fr. Phan and I extend our congratulations. We will keep you in our prayers, and we are going to schedule a Mass to celebrate your accomplishments in the future. Whatever your plans are for the next year we pray for God's blessings on your future plans. God Bless everyone and we pray for your health and for the Lord's peace in your heart.
