A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

I am sure you will notice that the windows have been replaced. There were clear signs that the windows had been leaking from the damaged wood that was found. We are fortunate that this was done now as the damage was minimal. The plan is to put stained glass on the inside and it will complement the beauty of the stained glass windows below. The doors on the east and the west will also be replaced with a glass door, that will have stained glass in the center of the panes of glass. I think it will be a very beautiful addition to the Church. If you would like to contribute to these projects in memory of a loved one, or just in support of these ideas, please contact me.

There are three collections that will be taken during the month of September. We have the annual Bishops Appeal for Vocations and Missionary Cooperative Collection, and we also will have the Good Friday collection during the month. Since we were not in Church for Good Friday, and that collection goes to support the Holy Land, the Franciscans who are custodians of the Holy Land, asked for the collection to be taken on September 13 (close to the Triumph of the Cross feast on September 14). The goal, which we need to meet for the Bishops Appeal for Vocation is \$12,650. You will receive a notice in the mail about the collection, and we will also have envelopes at Church to help us contribute and make our goal.

The Missionary collection will be a little different and hopefully it will continue to be done this way in the future. There are a number of missionary appeals that we can choose from to support, then we will take up a collection for the that effort on a Sunday in September. This year we will help the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet are in Canto Chico and Tacna, Peru who minister among families living in extreme poverty. The pandemic has compounded their situation, and many are without food. With funds from donations, the Sisters are buying food, bagging the food and distributing the food. The Sisters have divided Canto Chico into sections. Families without food display a white flag to indicate that they have absolutely no food. The sisters and some volunteers in the town provide food to these families. In Tacna, the sisters provide vouchers for grocery stores. Trying to provide for so many families is quite a challenge. We will take this collection on the weekend of September 26 and 27.

You can begin next weekend contributing to the Good Friday or the Missionary Coop collections by simply placing an envelope in the collection basket marked Good Friday or Missionary Coop. Thank you for your support of these initiatives.

Last week in my homily I said that I would give a couple of links to articles that will help you prepare for the upcoming November election. Please continue to pray for Fr. Phan as he is recovering from his surgery. He returned to Seward on Tuesday and is regaining strength each day. Your prayerful support is greatly appreciated and we hope that he will recover quickly. God Bless you.

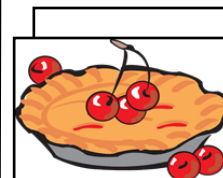
