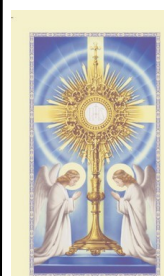

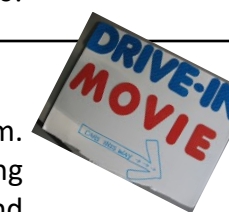
RCIA
