#### A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

I put a voting information from the Catholic Bishops in the bulletin a couple of weeks ago and stated that the Nebraska Catholic Conference did not at that time have a voter's guide. I received their information this week and you can find their guide at www.NebraskaCatholicVoter.com. This will provide information about all local candidates and also have information for every county in Nebraska.

This weekend is the collection for the Holy Land this weekend. September 14<sup>th</sup> is the feast of the Exultation of the Cross making this an appropriate time for this collection. Mount Calvary is inside the Church of the Holy Sepulcher is the most important Church in the Holy Land. The entrance to the Church provides a constant reminder of the importance of support this annual collection. During the time of Crusades Muslim armies would take the Holy Land from the Christians and then prevent them from going into to the Churches. They would take the doors out and cover the entrance with stone blocks. Today, you can still see the way the entrance to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher was blocked during those days. It is very clear looking at the entrance that this happened numerous times as the possession of the church changed hands over and over again. Today there is still a great need for support of the Christians in the Holy Land, as various political groups are trying to push them out. Your support of the Holy Land collection will help keep a Christian presence in the Land of Jesus.
