Dear Parishioners,

The spring is a busy time of year, but also are great time of the year. There are so many celebrations. We rejoiced last weekend with our First Communicants. We will soon have Confirmation and Graduation, and next weekend we have May crowning. Even if you do not have someone receiving these sacraments, events or participating in them, you are welcome to attend, and encouraged to pray for them. Part of being a church is to rejoice with those rejoicing and mourning with those in sorrow. We have also had a few funerals here lately, and we can comfort these families with our prayers and kindness.

May Crowning is really an important spiritual event that helps us grow in our love of God. God works in ordinary ways and yet these events are also extraordinary. We celebrate God coming into our world in a natural order, being born with a human mother, and living in our order and time. God's choice of Mary to be the mother of our savior and our mother reminds us of the importance in honoring her. He honored her by choosing her to be the mother of our savior and we honor her in our procession in a May crowning. First Communicants can wear the clothes they wore for the sacrament, and all children can join in the procession to give honor to our Blessed Mother.
