A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

I hope last week was not too confusing when we spoke about the Mission Coop collection. St. Vincent students made some beautiful envelopes for this collection. They were on the table next to the bulletins. They can be used by anyone to put your donation in for relief from the hurricane that hit Haiti. You can still give a gift to help this effort, using the Missionary Cooperative envelope in your packet, one of the student envelopes or one you make yourself.

This month we begin the annual collection for Vocations. We need to raise nearly \$12,000 to support the education of our seminarians. This is truly an investment for future generations and it is propagation of faith in our communities. In the Acts of the Apostles, the Ethiopian says “How can I understand this passage, unless there is someone to instruct me?” Everyone can say the same thing and that is the reason Jesus founded the Church on the Apostles and sent them to proclaim the Gospel. We are supporting this work of Jesus in our support of the education of priests. They are sent by Jesus, and we help that in supporting their education. Please in your charity, support this worthy work!

Next week the RCIA begins. We will begin at 6:30 pm, and you can simply show up in the Social Hall for the first meeting.
