A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

I mentioned last week that the feasts of All Saints and All Souls are Monday and Tuesday. For All Souls day, a plenary indulgence can be received for a deceased person. An indulgence is the pardon of the temporal punishment that is due to past and forgiven sins. We can gain an indulgence by doing certain works of penance or charity, or by saving certain prayers that the Church has picked out, and under the conditions that the Church sets down. The Church has the authority to grant an indulgence because it has the job to give out to people all that Jesus won for us in His death and resurrection, and all that the saints won by cooperating with God's grace. This would be like our neighbor not only forgiving us for breaking his window, but also telling us we do not have to replace the window if we would make some gesture of sorrow and good will, like bringing him a plate of the cookies he loves, which is certainly an easier and cheaper thing to do than replacing the window. You must be baptized, in communion with the Pope, have the intention to gain the indulgence, be in the state of Grace, or go to confession a few days before performing the work, free from attachment to sin, and receive communion several days before or after performing the work, and pray one Our Father and one Hail Mary, or any other prayer, for the intentions of the Holy Father, to complete the indulgence. On All Souls day, you can visit a Cemetery or a Church, praying for the departed person, and as long as the other conditions are met, the departed person will receive a plenary indulgence.

All Saints day Masses are not obligatory since the feast falls on Monday, but it is a Solemn Feast and should be attended. It is a good reminder that there is a universal call to holiness, and attendance at Mass and reception of communion are Jesus' gifts to us to help us on the road to holiness.

There are two places accepting winter clothing that is in good condition for people that are in need of warm clothing. Hillcrest Community Church is collecting clothing (flyer on the bulletin board) and these items will go to Native American persons. Locally, Blue Valley will take clothing and distribute them to people in our community in need.

During the month of November we will be taking financial donations for the poor in our community. This money will be given to our St. Vincent de Paul Society and they will help people in Seward County with financial needs, and help them form a plan for future sustainability. God Bless. -Msgr.
