
A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This week I met with some of the people that are traveling to the Holy Land with me in June. I received the whole list of pilgrims, and there are fourteen people going to this holy place. The breakdown of men and women is nearly 4:1 in favor of women. I was asked why more men do not go? I don't know for sure, but this is very typical. Then I started thinking about the scriptures and thought, not only is this typical, but it is traditional. The women were the first to go to the tomb. There were three women and one man at the foot of the cross. There is a greater receptivity to spiritual love and intimacy for women than men, in the nature God gave us. The reality for all that go to the tomb and see that the Lord is truly risen, is that there are greater responsibilities given due to the encounter. The Apostles saw the risen Lord, and they were sent out to tell that good news. Everyone that goes to the Holy Land, encounters the Lord, and He will send them out to share that good news in one way or another.

I am thinking that this may be the beginning of a new ministry for me. As we watched the program on Formed for Holy Week, there were pictures of a lot of the Holy Land sites that I have been to before. As I watched, I started getting excited about going there again. The excitement is connected to faith, and love for Jesus, and the desire for that love to grow. I know other priests that are trying to get as many of their parishioners as possible to go to the Holy Land. I think in a couple of years, I will be ready to take another group to the Holy Land, so start thinking now if the Lord is calling you to encounter the fifth Gospel which is the Holy Land.

Keep praying in thanksgiving for rain, for good weather for farming and ranching, for those who are ill and distressed, and the many other intentions on your heart. The Lord hears our prayers, and answers them in the best way possible. Our prayers will help us grow in our trust in the Lord, and we will grow in gratitude as we understand the way He answers these prayers. God Bless you.
