A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This is the last week of school, and in all respects the school year has passed by quickly. This year has been great from an academic viewpoint and from a faith perspective. The children did very well in the reading curriculum and also in the standardized testing. Again this year, our students preformed at the top of our Diocesan schools. That is a great accomplishment given the small size of our school, and the effect one low score can have on our class average. I enjoy celebrating Mass every day with the children and talking with them during Mass. I will ask questions, and help them understand the stories in the bible, and help them apply these to their daily lives. I am truly grateful for the support of our parish for our school, and for the tremendous work done for the children of our parish by our teachers and staff.

The Jews are praying there every day, and people from all over the world place their intentions before the praying Jews in the cracks in the wall.
