A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

I am grateful for the work of the members of our Facility committee and the many volunteers that donate their time, and talents to help keep our buildings and grounds in great shape. Unfortunately the lack of rain and a severe storm, has not done much for our farmers, or for our lawn. Amazingly, there is still a silver lining to these difficulties when we look for them. We will be getting a new roof sometime because of the storm, as obviously many others in the community are in the process of getting their roofs repaired. We are waiting for our Insurance Company to give us the approval to move forward on this repair. We have completed work on the stucco and steel supports, and are almost finished with the mortar repair, and replacing the crumbled sidewalk. These repairs are costly (\$30,000) but your generous support of the Joy of the Gospel campaign and our Spirit maintenance appeal, makes these projects possible. Thank you.

We have some great things coming up, with the Corn Holy tournament in September, and we are planning a fundraiser for the Women's Care Center in October. We are just starting the planning of the October event, and can you believe the idea is going to include a bicycle? Last year during a bicycle ride the idea came up, and we ran out of time to plan it before the weather changed. This year may be a little simple, but we hope to raise some money, and we hope the details can be laid out soon. We will need some help on the day of the event, and if you have a passion for the Women's Care Center and supporting their work, please contact me to offer your time and talent.

The outdoor classroom continues to take shape, and we are getting closer to having it put together for more practical use. I am so grateful to the volunteers that have helped us to get to where we are today. I am also asking for some simple donations for this area. We need pine cones, pods and sea shells, or other natural items that children can view under a magnifying glass. We can use a couple of sewing measuring tapes, and we can use some Brome seed. The area is for discovery and learning about natural things, and it is a place of natural habitat. The grass will be kept low during the school year, but we want the experience of natural plants. We also want to put three raised planters in the area, so if there is someone that desires to make or donate those items, it would be a tremendous gift. That is enough begging for this report. Thank you for all you do!
