A LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

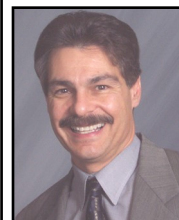
Dear Parishioners,

This week Fr. Rolling spoke to the parish about the Eucharist and Family life. His talk can be viewed on our Facebook page. I am appreciative of his work and presentation, and it is a good reminder to us of the amazing calling that God has given to parents, and how children are a part of that amazing work. He reminds us that the Family is the vital cell of society and together with their parents, children help to make a powerful statement to and build up this world in which we live. His talk is worth the time to listen to, and it may help you refocus your attention on the work of family life, and help you see the vital work families are called to strengthen our society. There is no shortage of bad news in our world today, and the little things we can do that are good, are signs of hope, and God's presence in our troubled world.

On Tuesday, at our first priest Study Day of the year, we received information about the Bishops Vocation Appeal. Our parish assessment for this annual collection is \$12,000. We have envelopes in our packets for this collection. For those who receive envelopes, please use that envelope to make your contribution to the support the education of our seminarians. If you do not receive envelopes, you can place your own envelope in the collection marking it with the words, "Vocations Collection". We know that the cost of education keeps rising, so your support is definitely needed to help the Diocese form our future priests. Thank you for the contributions already given for this appeal, and I hope that others will help us reach our goal by the end of October.

Also, at our study day, we heard three talks about the sacrament of the Eucharist from the members of the Emmaus Institute. I was speaking to Fr. Rolling about the talks, and his comment was that it is "amazing how they used the scriptures to help us understand the Eucharist and the Mass, and did not once speak about the scriptures which recount Jesus' institution of the Eucharist". The scriptures are so rich and supportive of our belief of the sacrifice of Jesus for our salvation, and is present in the celebration of the Mass and in the sacrament of the Eucharist. These talks helped our priests grow in a deeper understanding of our precious faith, and hopefully we will be able to communicate this gift to our parishes. This time of Eucharistic renewal, is a time for all of us to delve deeper into our faith, grow in our appreciation of it, and receive the grace from our Blessed Lord to share these truths with others.
