

"Catechism in a Year" and/or "Bible in a Year" podcasts with Fr. Mike Schmitz

The episodes are readily available and free of charge via Ascension-and you can listen to them whenever it is convenient for your schedule. 365 episodes each will cover the entirety of the Bible and the Catechism. The episodes are 15-25 minutes long. Fr. Mike provides explanation, insight, and encouragement with regard to the Catechism, giving you a better understanding of what it means to be Catholic and how the beliefs of the Church come together. The Bible podcasts cover two or three readings providing commentary, reflection, and prayer along the way. You will gain greater confidence in your understanding of Scripture and experience the transformative power of God's word daily.
