LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

On Friday was the Anniversary of the Dedication of our Cathedral in Lincoln. The whole Diocese celebrates this anniversary, and outside of the Cathedral parish it is designated as a Feast Day. In the Cathedral parish it is a Solemnity. The same is true on the anniversary of any Church. The anniversary of the dedication of St. Vincent de Paul Church is October 7th, and it is a Solemnity here. There is an obligation to celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of the Church. I am not sure how serious the obligation is, but I do know that I have been remiss in celebrating the anniversary of the dedication of the Churches that I have been pastor. The question you may be asking, and that I asked too, is why is this so important?

St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians speaks of the Church as made up of living stones, and the scriptures speak about us being created in the image and likeness of God and being temples. Church's are dedicated to be houses of prayer and worship. They are dedicated for this purpose, so that people can come and encounter God, and be transformed by Him. Our Churches are dedicated to make Christ present in the Eucharist, so that Jesus resides in these Churches. We come to the Church to receive Him in the Eucharist, have our sins forgiven in Confession, have our marriages consecrated, and in general to receive Christ in many ways to be built up into beautiful temples dedicated to love and serve God.

This year on October 7th, Bishop Conley will be here to consecrate our new altar. This date was selected because it is the anniversary of the dedication of St. Vincent de Paul Church. This year also is the 50th anniversary of the dedication of our Church. I encourage you to think about the many Masses celebrated here, the numerous baptisms, weddings and other sacraments that persons have received here in this Church. It is a time to celebrate the many ways God has sanctified people here in this Church, consecrated for this purpose. We do not have much time between now and October 7th, but please put that date in your calendar. Plan on coming to celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of our Church, and pray for God's transforming grace for the people that will come to this Church in the next 50 years and beyond. We are truly blessed with our Catholic faith, and our good God is always faithful and true! God Bless you.
