





## LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This week I received an email from Archbishop Coakley's administrative assistant informing me that we will receive a relic of Blessed Stanley Rother for our altar. This is great news, and I am very appreciative of this gift. Blessed Stanley Rother studied at Mount Saint Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD. This is the same seminary that I attended, and I remember that we often would sit at the shrine dedicated to him and pray. We heard stories about him and his work in Guatemala. I did not comprehend or realize that he was martyred only a few years before I entered the seminary. He was martyred in 1981, and I entered the seminary in 1984. He is the first American martyr which adds to the honor of having a relic of this holy man. His life shows that he has many things in common with this community. He grew up in a farming community, and he had expertise in many of the activities that you are involved in daily. I encourage you to read about him. Bishop Conley gave us a book entitled, "The Shepherd that did not run" emphasizing the courage and love of this great priest.

I have a Parish Council meeting next week, and one of the items that will be on our agenda is the celebration of the consecration of the altar on October 7th. We have the Corn Holy tournament that day which will draw a lot of people to the parish. When asked if it is too much to have it on the same day the Bishop will be here. I said, "no", since I believe, it will add to the festivity of the day. I suggest that we do something after Mass on the 7<sup>th</sup> to continue the celebration of the day, and that is what we will talk about at our meeting. We have a lot to be grateful for as we look at the long history of the parish. It is too easy to forget about the past, so being grateful for the past inspires us to work on doing the good things each day, and being a part of continuing the good, and making it present daily, and into the future. God Bless you.
