

LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

Pope Francis recently promulgated a document from the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith, Fiducia supplicans, which outlines that gives direction for blessings for people, including people that are in same-sex relationships. This action has received criticism from both sides, liberal and conservative Catholics. The liberal side is upset that the Church does not bless unions of same sex couples and recognize their union as a marriage. The Church has a definition of marriage that will not change, and that a marriage is between a man and a woman.

The conservatives are also upset, since there is a feeling that the Church is taking a step in the wrong direction. Pope Francis clearly points out that the blessing is for individuals, not couples, and that it is not to take on any type of liturgical impression. This is a spontaneous blessing, that persons randomly asks for, which is something that we already do. Also, if you think about the blessing at the end of Mass, it is given to all present, which includes, Catholics, non-Catholics, saints and sinners!

The question is, why did the Church see it necessary to make this statement now. I believe that Pope Francis is teaching and trying to draw those on the fringe back to the fullness of the faith. The German Catholic Bishops are trying to push the Pope to redefine marriage and are extremely upset with this statement from the Doctrine of Faith. Pope Francis is praying and hoping that they will return to the fullness of the faith, and is giving them, and the world that wants a redefinition of marriage, a clear teaching, and encouraging all people to ask for God's grace through blessings that the Church can give, to help them live their faith.

I hope this answers some of the questions that you may be receiving, or that you may have about this statement from Rome. God Bless you.

The Epiphany Blessing - is a simple blessing where SVDP students follow Msgr. Tucker through the school as he uses Blessed chalk to mark the upper threshold of the doors in the school. Each door is marked with 20 + C + M + B + 24. The C M B serves two meanings; the initials of the wisemen, and the Latin phrase, Christus mansionem benedicat (May Christ Bless this House) The 20 / 24 marks the beginning of the new year. This is a centuries old tradition that reminds us that our homes (classrooms) reflect the presence of Christ's love! Happy New Year!
