LETTER FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

Next Saturday is the Walk for Life in Lincoln. We have had some nice days for the walk, but I don't know, with our recent weather if we can count on a nice day this year. Since the Roe v Wade decision was overturned, the proabortion groups have been very active. They are currently trying to get enough signatures to place a bill on the November ballot that could change all of the prolife work our Legislature has done. These changes in the last year remind me of the importance of the Walk for Life. If you are unable to attend the Walk for Life, please pray for an end to abortion, and pray for mothers that are making difficult decisions with regards to an unplanned pregnancy.

It also reminds me of the importance of providing assistance to women that are confronted with an unplanned pregnancy. It is one thing to say we are pro-life, but it is very important for us to back up those words with action. We need to pray and we need to support agencies that help women in the difficult situation of an unplanned pregnancy, particularly those who have no support, or financial means to provide for their child.
