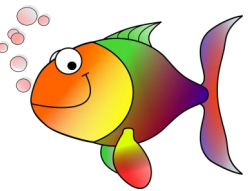

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence.

FASTING means eating only one full meal with two smaller meals, which together do not equal the full meal. No snacks or eating between meals allowed. Fasting obliges all Catholics between ages 18-59.

ABSTINENCE means eating no meat, nor soup or gravy made from meat. Abstinence obliges all Catholics over the age of 14. Sickness, hard labor, pregnancy, etc. automatically excuse a person from these obligations. Nevertheless, these regulations are serious obligations. In cases of doubt or question, ask your pastor or your priest confessor.
