MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners.

As we begin Lent, we are focusing on the celebration of Easter. Focusing on Easter, we also focus on the Easter Vigil, and it will be at the vigil that we will have baptisms of adults and professions of faith made by converting Christians. The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults has been going on since the beginning of September, and now we are in the final stretch. Your prayers for those completing the OCIA are greatly appreciated. We have been studying the Catholic faith by reading the Catechism of the Catholic Church. In this arduous process, we have come to a deeper understanding of what the Catholic Church teaches, and now it is time for those in the OCIA to complete their journey at the Easter Vigil.

Lent is also a journey for every member of St. Vincent's, and it is important to put forth the time and effort to grow in faith. The reading for Friday from Isaiah asks the question why God does not listen to the people. They say, we are engaged in penitential practices, but God does not listen. He responds that it doesn't appear that the penitential practices are not focused on conversion. Behaviors are not changing, so offer the penitential practices for the grace of conversion. The journey of Lent is a time of self-examination. We look deeply into our daily behavior and compare them to the life of Christ. We ask ourselves how we can imitate Jesus and offer our Lenten practices for the grace to follow Jesus more closely. Keep up the good work of your Lenten practices and ask for the grace of conversion. God Bless you. -Msgr. Tucker


FIRST CONFESSIONS
