MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

A week of Lent is complete, and I hope you are growing in your life with God. I announced last weekend that we will have the Stations of the Cross each Friday of Lent in the evening at 7 pm along with 3 pm stations, and that I will hear confessions before the Stations, even before the 3 pm Stations. After last Friday I was asking the question, “how can we create a tradition of praying the Stations?”. I think praying the Stations is an important devotion. We contemplate the sacred suffering of Jesus, and that He did this out of love. This is a key part of our spiritual life. It is important for us to contemplate God’s love for us, and it motivates us to live our lives in loving service to Him. I then thought about how I have offered Stations in the past years. It has really been hit or miss! That does not form a tradition, or emphasize the importance of this devotion. That is the reason for the announcement last weekend, and the desire to have the Stations every Friday. I hope you will find time, either at 3 or 7 pm to attend the Stations. If not, please take time to come to Church at a time when it is convenient for you and pray the Stations, they will help you in your spiritual growth this Lent!

On Monday, the Parish and Finance Council interviewed two companies to conduct a feasibility study for future expansion of St. Vincent, though it is important to explain what our hope is in this process. The feasibility study is more than focusing on future building, and is much more than trying to discern how much money can be raised in a future campaign. The focus is on the future and on communicating a vision for the future, and listening to parishioners as they hear the message. It is about forming unity and formulating a plan for the future, and working together to prepare for the needs of future generations. Obviously the question about money will arise, but if the other questions are not answered about purpose, goal and needs for the future, the question about money is a not even important. You will have the opportunity to participate in the study, and it probably will not begin until after Easter. Currently we will be working on the planning for the study, so I ask for your prayers, and if ask to participate in the planning to help in any way you are able. God Bless you.

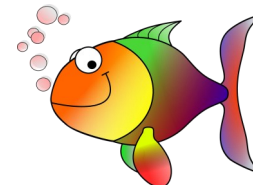

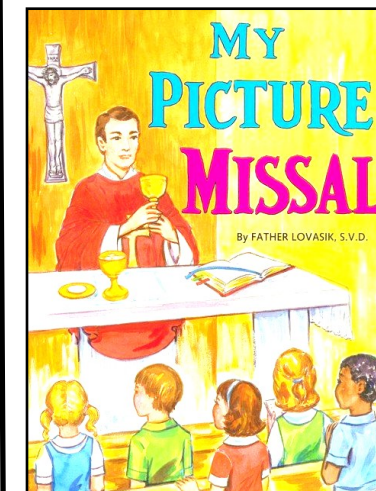
