MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have First Communion, so please remember to pray for the children receiving the sacrament, and for their families. The tradition here that has the parents come up with their child as they receive communion for the first time is good. The visible sign of parents and child coming to the altar together, is a fulfillment of the day when their child was baptized. After a child is baptized we invite the parents and family to come before the altar to say the Our Father with this invitation. "this child, reborn through Baptism, is now called a child of God, for so indeed he (she) is. Through Confirmation he (she) will receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit and, approaching the altar of the Lord, he (she) will share at the table of his Sacrifice, and will call upon God as Father in the midst of the Church".

Approaching the altar of the Lord, sharing at the table of Sacrifice, we call upon God as Father. This is a good reminder to us of the attitude we need to have as we approach the altar to receive communion. We are being fed from the table of His Sacrifice. He died for us, and it is represented to us at the altar. "This is my Body, which is given for you!" His sacrifice is for our salvation, and we are to share in His sacrifice, by sacrificing for others. We come to the altar to be fed by Jesus, to have strength to engage in sacrificial love. We also come before the altar as children of God, calling God our Father. We come to our Father, we give Him worship, praising Him for His presence in the Eucharist, and to receive the help of our Father to live a sacrificial loving life.

The family coming together to receive communion is a visible sign of the call to holiness. I encourage you to come together to Mass as a family as often as you can, and receive communion together, asking for the grace as a family to grow in holiness. This brings great peace and joy to the home, and it begins with prayer at home, and with attendance at Mass and receiving Jesus into your life in communion. You are like Mary, Joseph, who together welcome Jesus into their home, and His presence made them the Holy Family. God Bless you

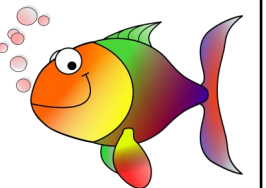
