MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This week I received an email from the Nebraska Catholic Conference about a bill that abortion rights supporters are trying to get on the November ballot. There is support from Abortion providers around the country to get enough signatures for Nebraskans to vote on this issue. The language of the bill is vague and is similar to the bill passed in Michigan. In Michigan the bill led to the repeal of all the Pro-Life efforts accomplished in that state. The same thing could happen here if the bill gets on the ballot and passes.

From the language in the bill it would overturn the current allowance of abortion during the first trimester and would extend it to at least 36 weeks of pregnancy and it would also take away parental consent for a mother under 18 years old seeking an abortion. It is important for us to be informed about legislation and act with knowledge, truth and faith.

Also the Catholic Conference is supporting the Opportunity Scholarship set up by the Legislature and approved by the Governor in last years Legislative session. There are 5000 children that are seeking assistance across our state to attend a private school. The funds comes from private gifts and from individuals, and corporations directing half of their state income tax to the scholarship fund. Currently they have \$600,000 in the scholarship fund, and are hoping to increase their funds significantly. If you would like more information about the Opportunity Scholarship please ask and I can direct you to the director of the scholarship, who can answer questions clearly, and help you if you would like to make a contribution.

These notices are just a reminder of the importance of our future generations, protecting them and supporting their growth. God Bless you!


