## **MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER**

#### Dear Parishioners,

I have two important announcements, the first from the Catholic Bishops of Nebraska, and the second from me.

# Joint Bishops' Statement in Response to the Public Launch of the Alternative Ballot Initiative Proposal

"Nebraska voters are likely to decide on two ballot measures regarding abortion this November. We have reviewed the proposed initiative to create a constitutional protection for preborn children in the second and third trimester that was released on Monday morning. Although imperfect in its protection of all preborn children, the proposal is a step toward safeguarding human life. Thus, it is morally permissible for Nebraskans to support this newly proposed initiative.

More importantly, we urge Nebraskans to unite in opposition to the other initiative proposal that wants to enshrine the evil of late-pregnancy abortion into the state constitution.

Women in Nebraska deserve support throughout pregnancy, not abandonment to the lifelong, physical and emotional trauma of abortion. The late-pregnancy abortion ballot measure fails pregnant women and is more extreme than meets the eye. Nebraskans should pray and work for its defeat and commit to even more support for pregnant women in need

#### Secondly, a new position is being created

I have been thinking about this for a while, and after speaking with the Parish Council about this idea, I have decided to create a new position which I am calling Coordinator of Youth and Adult Faith Formation. expressed to the Parish Council that we have a responsibility to build the church by developing the faith of parishioners. This position will focus on High School and College students, and Adult Faith formation. There will be collaboration with our director of CCD, God-teen parents, spirituality committee, and Concordia employees (Teresa Hain, and Rev. Russ Sommerfeld). Retreats, conferences, pilgrimages, and mission trips scheduling and educational support for God-teens will be part of the work entrusted to this position. I will be the primary person overseeing this work, but there will be a need for cooperation and support from other employees and parish members. This position was created because there is a need, and also due to the availability of a person to fill this position. Beth Nemec has been working at Aquinas High School in Campus Ministry the last few years, and decided the Lord is calling her to something new. In my conversations with her, I believe that she will be able to meet the responsibilities of this new position. Please welcome her, though she is not new to this parish. Pray for her and the direction that I feel the Lord is calling us to prepare our youth and adults to proclaim the faith and live it in this changing world.
