MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for making Spirit 2024 successful. I am grateful for all of the donations this year, and for the cooperation of many persons to make this event a success. The committee that worked so hard this year already has ideas for next year. The date that is being proposed for next year is March 1, 2025, which is the weekend before Lent begins. That sounds like a great time to have our Spirit celebration. Personally, and I think most would agree that things get really busy in the Spring, so the earlier date should be better. This annual event is a great way for us to have an enjoyable evening and also raise significant funds to help our parish. All of the money raised provides for our general operating expenses, funding all activities of parish life, utilities, facility upkeep, adult and youth education, and staff salaries. When I look at Spirit, I see it providing a financial boost to the work of the Church that is necessary, and I applaud you for your support in keeping the work of St. Vincent's going!

This week Fr. Hottovy asked if we could keep the Divine Mercy image in front of the altar during the Easter season.
