MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

I mentioned this before, but please take note that there will be a significant change Memorial Day week. This will be the first Convocation for priests that is required for our attendance. The Convocation begins Monday evening, May 27 and concludes at 1 pm on Thursday, May 30th. During that time, Fr. Harlan Waskowiak from Geneva will be celebrating daily Mass here on Tuesday and Wednesday, and he will also be the priest to call in case of an emergency. The Convocation is being held in Kearney, so it will not make it too easy for Fr. Hottovy or I to get back to Seward quickly.

On Tuesday and Wednesday, May 28 and 29, Mass will be celebrated at 7:15 am. He will then go to David City to celebrate Mass, and then travel to York for Mass. Since neither Fr. Hottovy or I will be present that week, I think it is best to continue the adoration hours on Monday and Wednesday without having the Eucharist exposed in the Monstrance. Jesus is still present in the Church, and your hour of adoration in Church is vitally important for your faith, and for those you are praying for. Please come to your hour on those days and pray, and then the following week we will resume exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

So just to clarify what is written, the following Masses will be celebrated the week of Memorial Day:

- ◆ Monday, May 27 - 7 am and 8:10 am Mass, with confession before 7 am
- ◆ Tuesday, May 28 - 7:15 am Mass, no confession prior to Mass
- ◆ Wednesday, May 29 - 7:15 am Mass, no confession prior to Mass
- ◆ Thursday, May 30 - 5:30 pm Mass, confessions prior to Mass
- ◆ Friday and Saturday will be dependent on Fr. Hottovy's availability, and there may be two Masses each day.

I hope this is not too confusing, and I hope that we do not have a convocation in the future. At least that is my feeling about it right now, which may change after I attend. That choice is out of my hands, and maybe I will be surprised and find it very beneficial. Please pray for your priests, and we always keep you in our prayers. God Bless you.
