Dear Parishioners,

This coming week Fr. Harlan Waskowiak will be celebrating Masses here on Tuesday and Wednesday morning at 7:00 am! His initial message to me said he would be here at 7:15 am, and then on Tuesday he changed it to 7:00 am, which is good, since it is our normal time for morning Mass. Fr. Waskowiak will also be the first priest to call (308-920-0240) if there is an emergency on those day, since Fr. Hottovy and I will be at the convocation in Kearney. Gloria and Tausha will know how to get in touch with us if needed.

Remember to pray for your deceased relatives and friends on Memorial Day and we will have Masses on Monday morning. Our offering of prayers for our deceased relatives is a tremendous gift of love to them. Our parish has a great tradition of offering Masses for personal intentions and for the deceased. The number of Masses that we have each year stays about the same, and since we have an obligation to offer the intentions we have within a year, it is necessary for us to send Mass intentions to other priests to offer. We send these to the retired priests, to the seminary and to some smaller parishes. The retired priests and the seminary generally do not receive requests to offer Masses, so by sending these Mass intentions to them, we are supporting these priests.

Remember that we have the Christ the King Sisters coming the first week of June for our summer program. Please sign your child up for the summer program. The Sisters do a great job, and the children learn a lot and have great time. We have Mass every day with the children and there are many fun activities for them. It is a way for them to experience the great joy of our faith, and it is something that will put into their hearts a love for Jesus and His Church. God Bless you!

National Eucharistic Pilgrimage

Beginning May 17, from 4 corners of the United States, and ending July 16, at the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, thousands of pilgrims will accompany Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament, in a procession across the United States: 4 routes, 60 days on the road, 1,000 hosts, 6,500 miles traveled, 100, 000+ total participants. The pilgrimage will have stops in all 3 dioceses in Nebraska, 8 in Grand Island, 11 in Lincoln, and 7 in Omaha.
