MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ROBERT TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

Yesterday, I received an email from Fr. Chris Eckrich, the Bishops Master of Ceremonies and personal secretary, regarding the petitions for the abortion-related ballot initiative. I spoke about this after Mass a couple of weeks ago, to let everyone know that the Catholic Conference in conjunction with the Bishops of Nebraska are supporting only one petition drive. There are currently three petitions that are circulating and again the Bishops are only supporting one of these petitions. I have included their statement about the third petition that has recently begun.

Statement from Bishops of Nebraska:

"Recently, a third abortion-related ballot initiative was launched. This effort, under the name Choose Life Now, seeks to provide protection in the state constitution for unborn children from the moment of conception. While the goal is one we all share, we are not going to allow signature collection at parishes on this third initiative. This ballot initiative effort is confusing for pro-lifers and some of its promoters are opposing the Bishops' clear guidance on the pro-life initiative already in circulation. This is not conducive to uniting Catholics against the pro-abortion proposal, which must be defeated.

Our focus has been and continues to be on urging Nebraskans to defeat the pro-abortion ballot initiative proposal and helping Catholics understand that they can support the Protect Women & Children pro-life ballot initiative proposal. Obviously, abortion is a hotly contested issue in our state, and we have to keep in mind the protection of human life, and the support for women who are responding to an unplanned pregnancy. Jesus is calling us to love in action to support women and children that are in very difficult situations. To be supportive we need to be keenly aware of legislation, of the effects of abortion on children, mothers and families, and the resources that are available to help women in need. God Bless you.
