As we celebrate Father's Day, it gives us the opportunity to reflect on God as our Father. # FR. HOTTOVY ANNIVERSARY

On Sunday June 23rd, Fr. Jamie Hottovy will celebrate 25 Years of Ordination as a Priest for the Diocese of Lincoln. Father will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving at 1:00 p.m., followed by a luncheon afterwards. There will be a reception following the Mass from 2-4 pm in social hall.

Father Hottovy was ordained May 22, 1999. Since his ordination he has been a member of the Building and Liturgical Commission for the diocese. He has been involved in the renovation, restoration, and building of new churches in the Midwest and beyond. During this time he has helped lead several diocesan trips to World Youth Days around the world. He has led many pilgrimages to the Holy Land and Europe, as well as in the US, that focus on the sacred beauty of the art and architecture found in Catholic churches.
