MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This week we received a tremendous gift from Rueben Lopez family. Rueben told me he had a statue of our Lady of Guadalupe to bring to us. I was thinking of a small statue, and he brought the beautiful, framed statue of Our Lady that is in Church. I am so grateful for this gift to St. Vincent's, as we have been asking for the intercession of Our Lady of Gaudalupe since the pandemic. She is the patroness of the America and patroness for the protection of all human life. Thursday for the feast of the Assumption the first reading was from Revelation (12:1-6, 10) and it clearly describes the image of Our Lady of Gaudalupe. You might want to read it while looking at the image of Our Lady.

Last weekend as I announced that we will conduct a Capital Campaign with the Steier Groups assistance, I mentioned that there is a lot of work to do in preparation to begin the campaign. During the Planning Study the Steier Group communicated everything they heard to me and the Parish and Finance Councils. Parishioners generally understand what is planned, but there are questions about the "why" of the project. During the next month and a half, we will be working on communicating answers to questions posed to the Steier Group. It is good to have questions, and it gives us an opportunity to clearly articulate the plan. The hope and prayer offered is for unity in the plan and purpose of this effort for future generations. I ask for your prayers as we begin this process, asking for God to help us keep our eyes focused on, and plan for the future, to use our many gifts to grow in faith, hope and love, and to work together to make Him known, loved and served.
