MESSAGE FROM MSGR. TUCKER

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, September 8th, is the birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary. There are only three birthdays that we celebrate in our liturgical year. Obviously, the birthday of Jesus, and then the birthdays of Mary and John the Baptist. Mary is the greatest woman ever born as the mother of the savior. The words of the prophet Jeremiah ring true for Mary and for each of us: "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord. Plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future". Jeremiah 29:11

God the Father had this plan for our salvation and created Mary for this purpose. God the Father has plans for each of us, and it is important, regardless of our age, to ask God to help us discern these plans. I say regardless of our age, because each and every day we should be focused on doing God's will. What is His will for you today? This is His plan for you today and every day! The words of the prophet are good to remember and even memorize.
