Dear Parishioners,

I was asked this week if we are still planning the Capital Campaign. I haven't written about it lately and so I will now. We have been working hard on the planning and organizing for the kick off of the Campaign. The kick off will be November 2nd! We have been putting together the case statement, meeting with Clark Enersen to fine tune the Master plan, writing prayers cards, preparing materials for you to explain the plan and invite your support, and organizing a team of volunteers. Mark and Lisa Peery, Glen and Pam Hochstein and Jeff and Janet Bohaty have been working closely with me and Bill Miklas as the leadership team. We also have another 10 couples working with us on the campaign.
